### **TEACHER VS. STUDENT COMPARISON**

*Can students apply what I am teaching to everyday lives?*

<b>T</b> — Students can apply what I am teaching to their everyday lives.	<b>92%</b>
<b>S</b> — I can apply what I learn to my everyday life.	<b>58%</b>

*Do I encourage students to explore career pathways?*

<b>T</b> — I encourage students to explore career pathways.	<b>80%</b>

*Am I aware of my students interests outside of school?*

<b>T</b> — I am aware of my students' interests outside of school.	<b>87%</b>

<b>T</b> — I know my students' academic interests and goals.	<b>84%</b>
<b>S</b> — My teachers know my academic interests and goals.	<b>35%</b>

<b>T</b> — I know what my students are passionate about.	<b>78%</b>
<b>S</b> — My teachers know what I love to do outside of school.	<b>28%</b>
